Substance Use Policy

Safe and responsible motorcycling activity is a major H.O.G. goal.

The use of an impairing substance is a serious personal responsibility involving the safety and welfare of family, riding friends and the individual H.O.G. member.

Impairing substances include but are not limited to alcohol and prescription or other drugs that may adversely affect one's judgment or ability to safely operate a motorcycle in all riding situations.

Use of an impairing substance before or during motorcycling activity is not safe, responsible behavior.

Tacoma H.O.G. Officers and Road Captains are leaders for all chapter events, and have pledged to avoid the use of impairing substances before and during official Tacoma H.O.G. motorcycling activities.

Therefore, for the benefit of the individual member, chapter Officers and Road Captains, and the Tacoma H.O.G riding membership in general:

Tacoma H.O.G. members should avoid the use of impairing substances before and during any Tacoma H.O.G. motorcycling activity.

At the point that the motorcycling activity is deemed concluded, a member should use good judgment and responsibility to determine the level of substance use, if any, that is appropriate and safe for that individual.
